

**ORDINANCE NO.920.133**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TEXT IN PLANNING AND ZONING REGULATIONS  
READOPTED IN ORDINANCE NO.920.128 REGARDING ADVANCED  
TECHNOLOGY CENTERS AND INTEGRATED ENERGY SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS the County readopted Planning and Zoning Regulations on July 15, 2025, in Ordinance No. 920.128;

WHEREAS, the County created the Simpson County Planning and Zoning Commission on July 15, 2025, in Ordinance No. 920.129, to administer and/or enforce Planning and Zoning regulations;

WHEREAS, the Simpson County Planning and Zoning Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 3, 2026, unanimously voted to recommend amendments to the Simpson County Planning and Zoning regulations;

WHEREAS, the County of Simpson, by and through its Fiscal Court, finds it is in the County's best interest to approve the proposed text amendments to the Simpson County Planning and Zoning regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County of Simpson, Kentucky, acting by and through its Fiscal Court as follows:

1) The sections of the Simpson County Planning and Zoning regulations listed below are amended as follows:

**2.3.7 Advanced Technology Centers- Data centers used primarily for the housing, operation, and management of computer servers, communications, networking equipment, and related technologies, and including cooling systems, power supply equipment, data storage systems, and on-site power generation systems, modular energy systems, gas turbine arrays, fuel cells, and battery energy storage systems.**

**2.3.63 Integrated Energy Systems- on-site energy generation and distribution infrastructure to support industrial operations utilizing technologies and fuel sources compliant with state regulations which may be operated independently as self-contained power solutions or connected to the TVA or other utility grid.**

**8.16.3E Other Conditional Uses Include:**

**j. Advanced Technology Centers, within the entirety of the unincorporated and incorporated areas in Simpson County.**

**k. Integrated Energy System Facilities, within the entirety of the unincorporated and incorporated areas in Simpson County.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.




